Session Description:

Teaching Questioning, Investigation, and Observation Skills Through Animal Behavior Study

In this session, teachers will explore resources to implement inquiry-based animal behavior ethogram studies in the classroom and/or during nature observation. Tools and student resources to support science and engineering practices such as asking questions, planning and carrying out investigations, using mathematics and computational thinking, and engaging in argument through evidence at K-8 levels will be introduced and discussed. Materials and accompanying strategies will be shared to support inquiry-based learning for lessons related to conservation, ecosystems, and animal behaviors and adaptations both in the classroom and during on-site learning at the zoo and/or in other environments where children encounter nature.
